

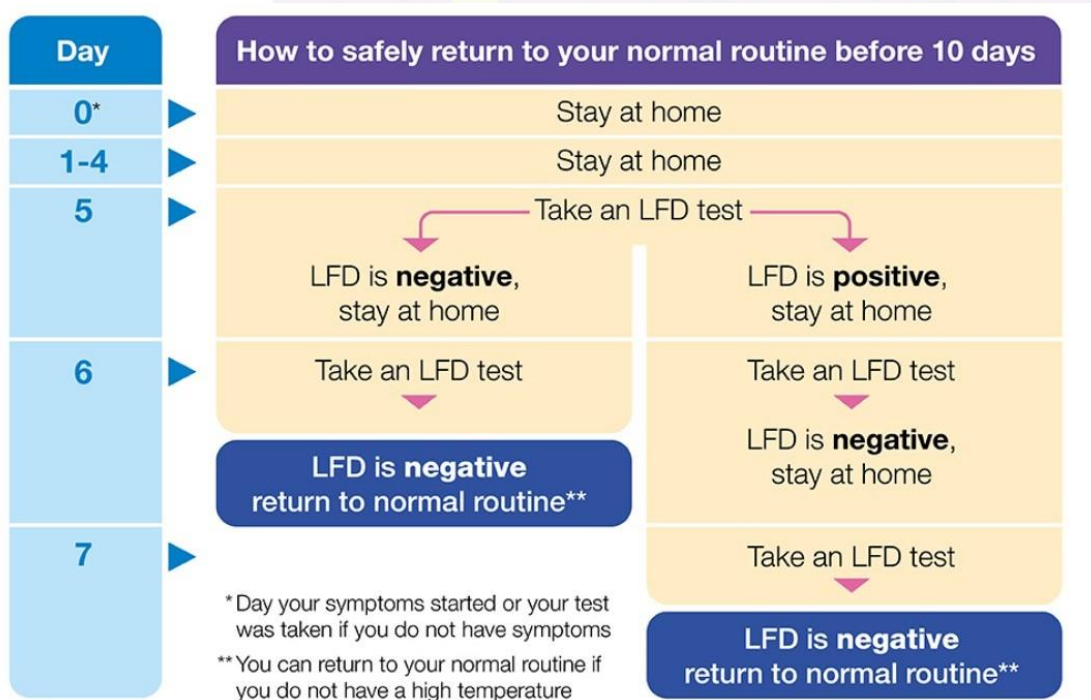

Dear Scientia Families,

Updated Covid19 Guidance

You will all be aware that most of the restrictions around Covid19 have now been removed by the UK Government. Please read below an outline of the current guidance and advice that you will need to follow.

- There is no longer a legal requirement for people infected with Covid19 to self-isolate, however, if your child has any of the main symptoms or has a positive test result, it is recommended that your child stays at home and avoids contact with other people.
- If your child has symptoms, you should get a PCR test.
- They should not attend school while they are infectious.
- They should take a Lateral Flow Test from 5 days after their symptoms started, followed by another on Day 6.
- If both tests are negative your child can return to school if they are well.





Measures to reduce risk in school will continue:

- Ventilation
- Hand hygiene
- Enhanced cleaning
- Contingency plans for an outbreak of COVID-19 – step up of measures

On the 1st of April there will be further guidance from the Government, I will then update you all with any further changes.
