Skills and knowledge to develop:

*Female butterflies lay eggs on plants. Caterpillars hatch from the eggs.
Caterpillars eat until they are fully grown, then they become a pupa.
A caterpillar pupa is called a chrysalis.
Butterflies drink nectar from flowers with their long tongues.
Butterflies, ladybirds and bees are insects.
Insects are small animals.
Insects have six legs and a hard outer shell. Some insects have wings.*

Making Ice Lollies

Skills and knowledge to develop:

*Ice is the solid form of water.
Water turns to ice (freezes) when it is very
cold.
When ice is heated, it melts, and becomes
liquid.
Follow instructions, including simple recipes, that
include measures and ingredients.*

Skills and knowledge to develop:

*Shows confidence in a variety of situations
and is able to select and use activities and
resources, with help when needed.
Asking for help when needed supports them to
achieve a goal that they have chosen, or one
which is suggested to them.*
