

History- Queen Elizabeth II and The Great Fire of London

Children will learn about events that are beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally. They will learn about The Great Fire of London and that it was a major fire that destroyed a large area of London in 1666. Children will learn that the fire started in a bakery on Pudding Lane. They will be taught about the monument that was built near to Pudding Lane to commemorate the Great Fire.

Children will also learn about Queen Elizabeth II and that she is the current monarch of the United Kingdom. They will gain an understanding of abstract terms such as, empire, civilisation, parliament, and peasantry.

Geography- Physical and Human characteristics of the UK and the capital city London.

Children will name and locate the four countries of the UK and their capital cities on a map, atlas, or globe. They will use basic geographical vocabulary to identify and describe physical features, such as beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley, and vegetation. They will identify the characteristics of settlements. Children will also carry out fieldwork tasks to identify characteristics of the school grounds. They will also identify patterns in daily and seasonal weather.
